Avoid Irrigation Irritation

When was the last time you watched your sprinklers run? If it's been a while, you might make some time to ensure they are functioning properly.

Irrigation timers and valves can wear out or malfunction, causing your irrigation system to be on longer than you schedule it to be. Broken sprinkler heads gush water, causing a lot of water-waste and making your other sprinklers dribble and not be effective because of pressure loss.

Remember to check in on your irrigation system a few times a year to ensure everything is flowing smoothly and properly.

How much indoor water do I use a day?

Using only modern water efficient fixtures you can expect to use:

Toilet: 1.6 gallons per flush

Shower: 2 gallons per minute

Sink: 2 gallons per minute

Dishwasher: 3.2 gallons per cycle

Washing machine: 14 gallons per cycle

If you use the toilet five times (8 gal), take a 10 minute shower (20 gal), run your bathroom sink for five minutes while getting ready (10 gal), and your kitchen sink for ten minutes while cooking and cleaning (20 gal), and do one load of dishes (3.2 gal) you're already using 61.2 gallons of water daily, and you haven't washed any clothes!

Remember, these figures are based on the most water efficient fixtures and appliances. If any of your fixtures or appliances are older or inefficient, you're using even more water than in this example.

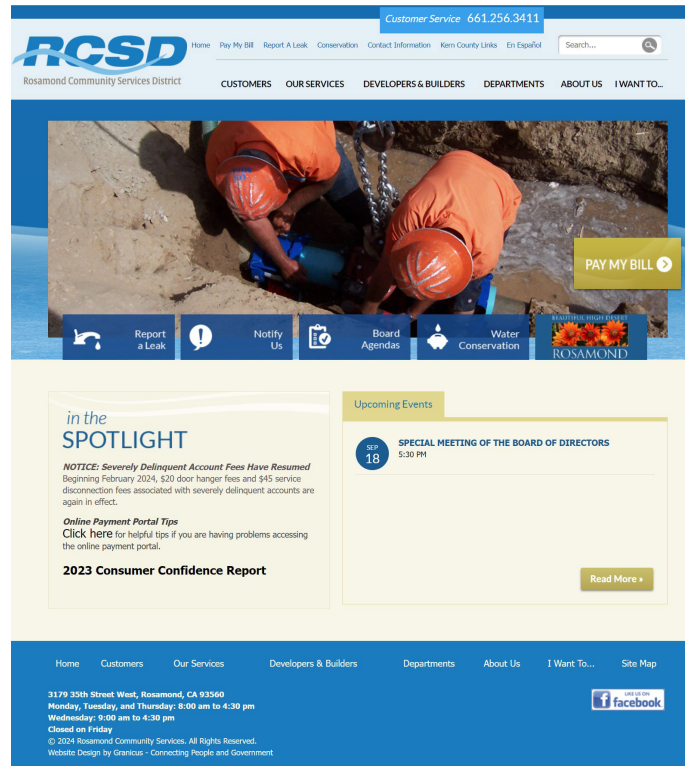
